

SSWLHC Membership Dues Structure

January 1, 2010

From January 1, 2010 through June 30, 2010 members of Chapters will become a National member and receive those member benefits, but will not be required to pay any fees to National. Chapters will transition the dues collection cycle to coincide with National beginning July 1, 2010.

(Year 1)- July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011

Chapters will collect dues at chapter rate and add \$10 per member to rebate back to national (50 members = \$500 to national for first fiscal period). Those who have been National members will not be able to retain National membership for 2010 by just paying their local chapter dues. This is a NEW member benefit. *Due date for rebates will be September 1, 2010.*

(Year 2)- July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012

National is responsible for collecting all member dues and sending rebates to Chapters. Membership dues will be set at the national rate per tier (see below) plus \$35 that will be sent back to Chapters for each member identified with that Chapter. Chapters will also receive rebates for those National members that have not previously been affiliated with a chapter in their geographic area.

As of January 1, 2010 SSWLHC will be considered a single-dues paying organization. Membership rates listed below are for 2009. Slight rate adjustments may occur in 2010/2011.
